Dear SABERS

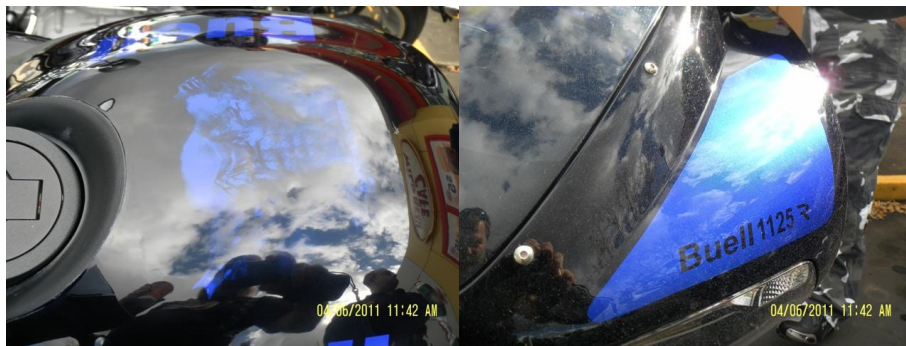
7.30am it was not looking good...heavy rain...no matter should clear up by the late 11am start...and it did!
